

Anyone can request a particular intention for which a Mass can be offered (for a living or deceased person, or for a special intention—in thanksgiving, for peace, healing, etc.). Great River Family Promise is launching a new program called The Promise House. The Promise House Program involves the purchase of mobile homes. A family that has been in the program will eventually be living in the mobile home as they continue to meet with their case manager. After a transitional period of time, the family will be given the home. This will increase affordable housing opportunities and continue the efforts to provide family stability long after the family leaves the program.

The first mobile home has been purchased in Corcoran. GRFP needs people to help IN CORCORAN in the following ways:

- Prior to April 27th to fill nail holes and paint ceilings
- On April 27th to help with painting and other tasks - especially bathroom
- On May 18th to help put the home together and finish task list

- Faucet

- Handicap accessible ramp
- Paint for interior of the house
- Smoke Detectors (Bluetooth)
- Stairs to emergency door

- Living room furniture
- Towels
- Window treatments


