

Normally, an offering (customarily \$10 in the Diocese of St. Cloud) is given for a Mass intention. (Can. 946--The Christian faithful who give an offering to apply the Mass for their intention contribute to the good of the Church and by that offering share its concern to support its ministers and works.)

Anyone can request a particular intention for which a Mass can be offered (for a living or deceased person, or for a special intention--in thanksgiving, for peace, healing, etc.). A family that has been in the program will eventually be living in the mobile home as they continue to meet with their case manager. After a transitional period of time, the family will be given the home. This will increase affordable housing opportunities and continue the efforts to provide family stability long after the family leaves the program.
