

(*Can. 946--The Christian faithful who* give an offering to apply the Mass for their intention contribute to the good of the Church and by that offering share its concern to support its ministers and works.)

Anyone can request a particular intention for which a Mass can be offered (for a living or deceased person, or for a special intention--in thanksgiving, for peace, healing, etc.). 
#### Journey of Faith



#### **MY BELOVED CHILD**

In today's Gospel we hear the voice from heaven call Jesus "my beloved Son" (Luke 3:15–16, 21–22). It tells us that Jesus is the Son of God.

At your baptism you were called a "child of God," that is, God's beloved son or daughter. With words and signs the Church reminds us of God's love for us, and the ways in which we must always try to act as a child of God. Connect the symbols with the prayers used in the Rite of Baptism that describe how we are to live as a chosen child of God.
