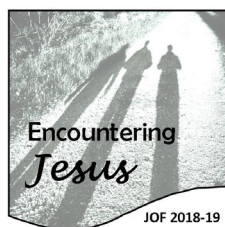
- **Lions Recycle For Sight**—Used eyeglasses/sunglasses/hearing aids can be recycled to provide aid to those in need in our communities.

Normally, an offering (customarily \$10 in the Diocese of St. Cloud) is given for a Mass intention. (*Can. 946--The Christian faithful who give an offering to apply the Mass for their intention contribute to the good of the Church and by that offering share its concern to support its ministers and works.*)

Anyone can request a particular intention for which a Mass can be offered (for a living or deceased person, or for a special intention—in thanksgiving, for peace, healing, etc.). 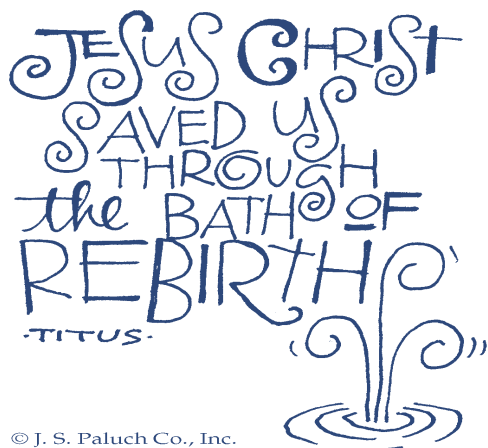

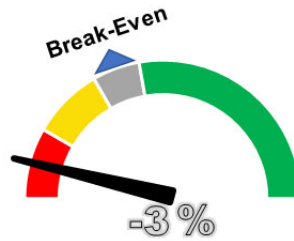

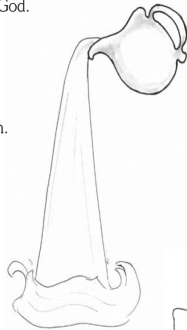
MY BELOVED CHILD

In today's Gospel we hear the voice from heaven call Jesus "my beloved Son" (Luke 3:15-16, 21-22). It tells us that Jesus is the Son of God.

At your baptism you were called a "child of God," that is, God's beloved son or daughter. With words and signs the Church reminds us of God's love for us, and the ways in which we must always try to act as a child of God. Connect the symbols with the prayers used in the Rite of Baptism that describe how we are to live as a chosen child of God.



See in this white garment
a sign of your Christian dignity.
Bring that dignity unstained
into the everlasting life of heaven.



Walk always as a child
of the light.
Keep the flame of faith
alive in your heart.

God anoints you with
the chrism of salvation.
Live always as a
member of his body.
